Report of Online Thalassemia Awareness Programme

The NSS Unit of Swarnamoyee Jogendranath Mahavidyalaya successfully organized an online Thalassemia awareness programme on May 8, 2021, at 11:00 AM via Google Meet. The event was aimed at raising awareness about Thalassemia, its causes, symptoms, prevention, and management. The resource person for the programme was Dr. Sandipan Mishra, BHOM, from Reyapara. The programme began with a brief introduction by the NSS Programme Officer, who welcomed the participants and introduced the resource person, Dr. Mishra. A total of 38 participants attended the session, including students, NSS volunteers, and some villagers from the local community. Dr. Mishra commenced his talk by explaining the genetic nature of Thalassemia, highlighting how it is inherited from parents to children. He discussed the various types of Thalassemia, such as Thalassemia Major and Thalassemia Minor, and explained the differences between them. He elaborated on the symptoms, which include severe anemia, fatigue, and bone deformities, among others. The resource person also emphasized the importance of early diagnosis and regular blood transfusions in managing Thalassemia. He discussed the role of prenatal screening and genetic counseling in preventing the transmission of Thalassemia to future generations. Additionally, Dr. Mishra touched upon the latest advancements in treatment, such as bone marrow transplantation and gene therapy, which offer hope for a potential cure. Following the informative presentation, there was an interactive Q&A session where participants had the opportunity to ask questions and clarify their doubts. Dr. Mishra patiently answered each query, providing valuable insights and practical advice. The programme concluded with a vote of thanks from the NSS Programme Officer, who expressed gratitude to Dr. Mishra for his enlightening talk and to all participants for their active involvement. The session was well-received by the attendees, who appreciated the knowledge shared and the importance of raising awareness about thalassemia.

Outcome:

- I) The programme increased awareness about Thalassemia, a genetic blood disorder, among participants. This included understanding its causes, symptoms, and the importance of early detection and treatment.
- II) Participants adopted preventive measures such as prenatal screening and pre-marital counseling.
