Report of Online Dengue Awareness Programme

The NSS unit and Students' Welfare Committee of Swarnamoyee Jogendranath College organized an online Dengue awareness program on 10th June 2021 via Google Meet. The session aimed to educate participants about Dengue fever, its symptoms, prevention, and treatment. The program commenced at 11:00 AM with a brief introduction by Prof. Arpita Majumder The key speaker for the event was Dr. Santanu Mahapatra from Reyapara Hospital, Dr. Mahapatra provided a comprehensive overview of Dengue fever, explaining that it is a mosquito-borne viral infection. He detailed the different strains of the Dengue virus and how they are transmitted. Dr. Santanu described Symptoms of Dengue: such as: High fever, severe headache, pain behind the eyes, joint and muscle pain, rash, and mild bleeding. Dr. Mahapatra emphasized the importance of early diagnosis and treatment. He mentioned different types of prevention measures. Lastly Dr. Mahapatra discussed the current treatment protocols for Dengue, A total of 69 participants attended the session, which included students, NSS volunteers, and villagers. Participants actively engaged with Dr. Mahapatra, asking various questions about Dengue prevention and management.

The interactive session helped clarify many doubts and provided valuable insights to the attendees. The program ended with vote of thanks by Prof. Arpita Majumder.

Outcome:

The program successfully raised awareness about Dengue fever among the participants. The attendees gained valuable knowledge on prevention and management, which they can share within their communities to help reduce the incidence of Dengue.
