

Report of Aranya Saptah Celebration

On the occasion of Aranya Saptah NSS unit 1 of Swarnamoyee Jogendranath Mahavidyalaya organized 7 days Workshop in virtual mode from 14.07.2021 to 20.07.2021 at 10:30 am. 40 NSS volunteers successfully participated in this programme. Dr. Ratan Kumar Samanta, Principal, Swarnamoyee Jogendranath Mahavidyalaya, inaugurated the programme by planting a mango tree. Dr Parimal Mandal, the NSS Programme Officer, spoke on the necessity of planting trees in our changing environment. Nayan Kumar Giri, SACT, department of Botany, offered practical advice on the kind of soil preparation required for some common plants (a list of which had been circulated beforehand to students), and the care they require. Students and staff were encouraged to prepare the soil. Day 2: Prof Aparesh Mandal of the department of Geography spoke on the necessity of afforestation to combat climate change. Day 3: This was a day of literary readings. Selected passages from Bengali, English and Sanskrit literary texts focusing on the importance of greenery to mankind and to all living creatures, were read out by teachers and students. Day 4: Dr Anindya Kisor Bhaumik spoke on the concept of biodiversity and measures taken at the local level to conserve biodiversity. Day 5: Prof Sanjit Debnath spoke on the Chipko movement and showed photographs of women clinging to trees, recounting how the movement had been effective in sensitizing the public of the day, and how often the economically underprivileged show greater environmental consciousness. Day 6: Dr Parimal Mandal conducted a quiz on the themes of afforestation, biodiversity, sustainability, and climate change, in which students and staff participated enthusiastically. Day 7: Successfully participated to given certificate and The programme ended with a valedictory address by Sri Prasad Ranjan Chakrabarti. The program could raise awareness about forest conservation, educate people about the importance of trees, and encourage them to take action by planting trees or supporting conservation efforts.

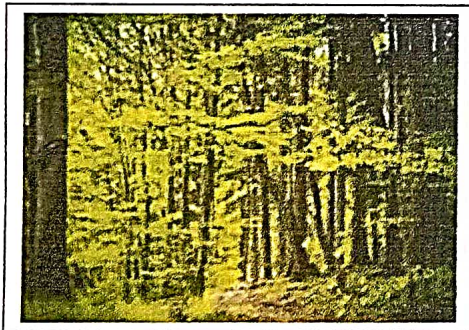
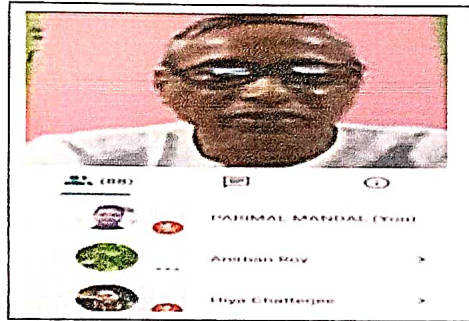
