Decisions proposed by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell(IQAC) (IQAC Meeting No. 08, dated: 06.06.2023)

1. Analysis of feedback on curriculum taken from students and teachers (2022-23)

After analyzing the feedback, the house unanimously decided that a proposal comprising the points mentioned below will be sent to the Governing Body for taking initiatives to improve the curriculum and enhance curriculum delivery:

- The curriculum should be redesigned to enhance the employability of students to facilitate their entry into the job market.
- The emphasis on case studies and fieldwork be augmented in the curriculum which will help a student acquire practical experience in applying acquired knowledge appropriately in real-life situations.
- The curriculum should be reframed by including more Skill Enhancing contents in all subjects to increase employability of the students.

- The college enter into Memoranda of Understanding with appropriate academic and industrial institutions to facilitate faculty exchange, visits to industrial institutions, partnerships with industry. This would serve to broaden the perspective of students about choosing appropriate academic and professional paths.
- The library's collection of reference books be enhanced. Books and media directly related to the curriculum and books and media useful in preparing for competitive examinations
