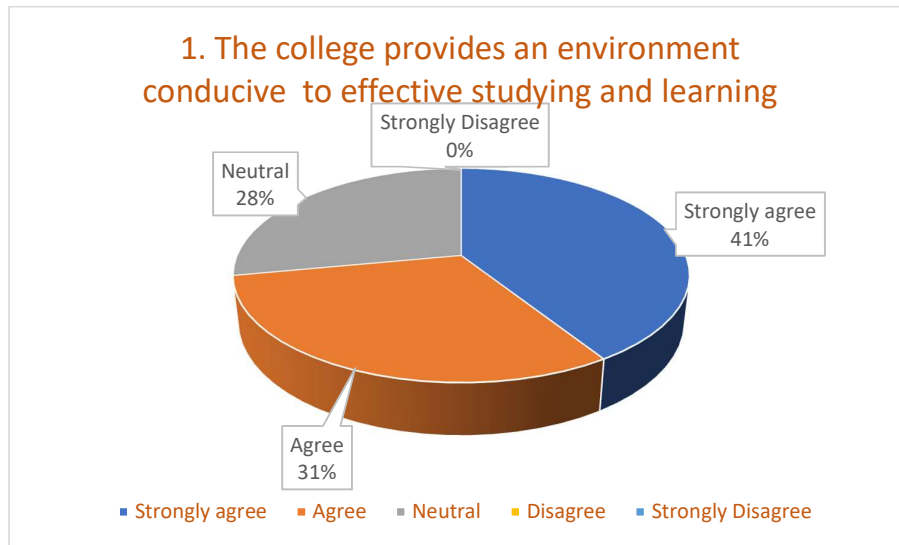

Interpretation of Feedback Results

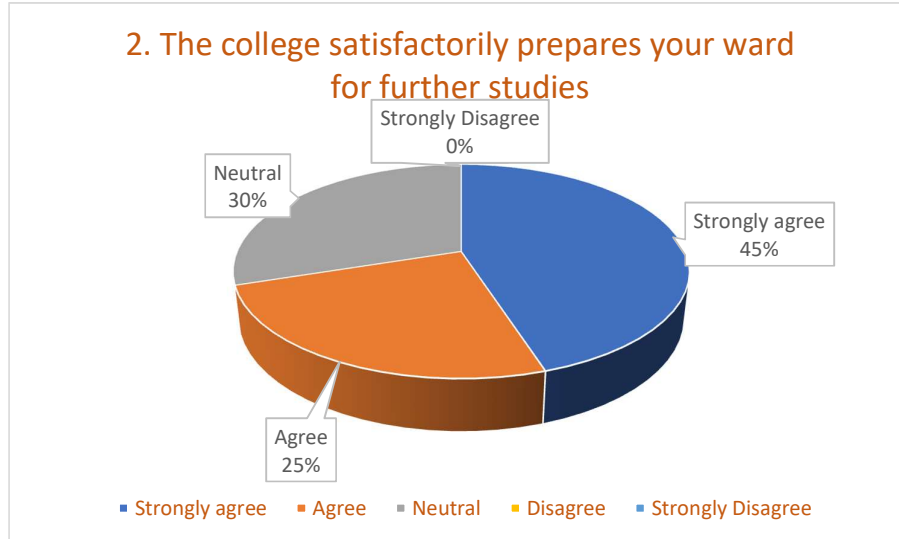
1. Conducive Studying and Learning Environment:

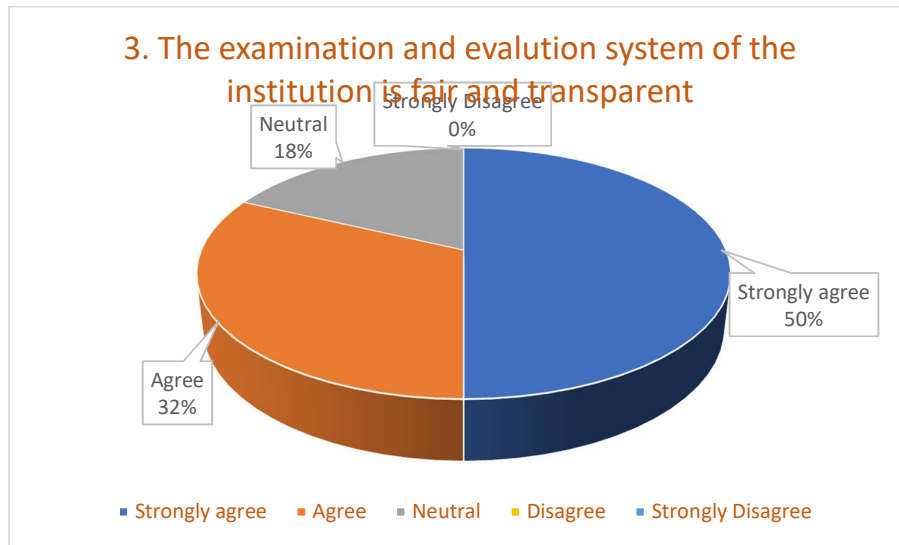
2. Preparation for Further Studies:

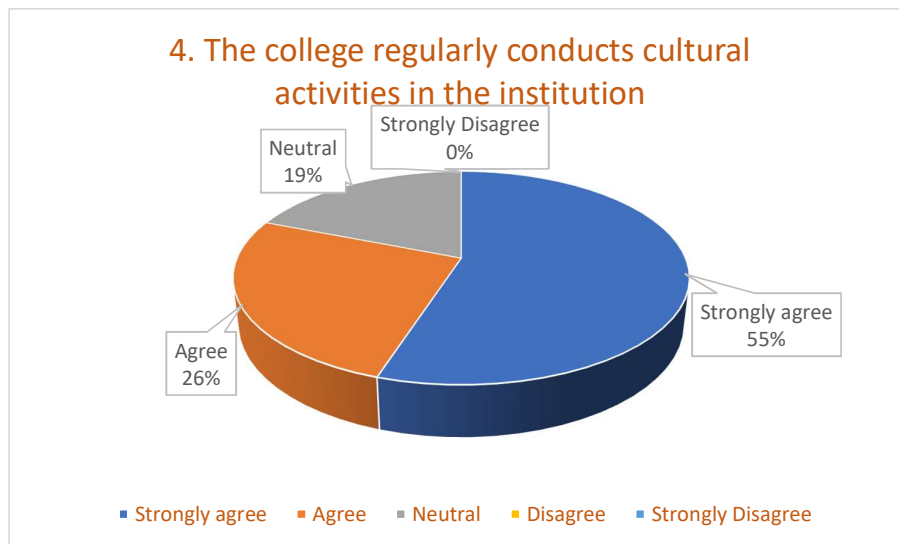
3. Fair and Transparent Evaluation System:

- The examination and evaluation system is perceived as fair and transparent by a significant majority (50 strongly agree, 32 agree), reflecting positively on the institution's assessment practices.



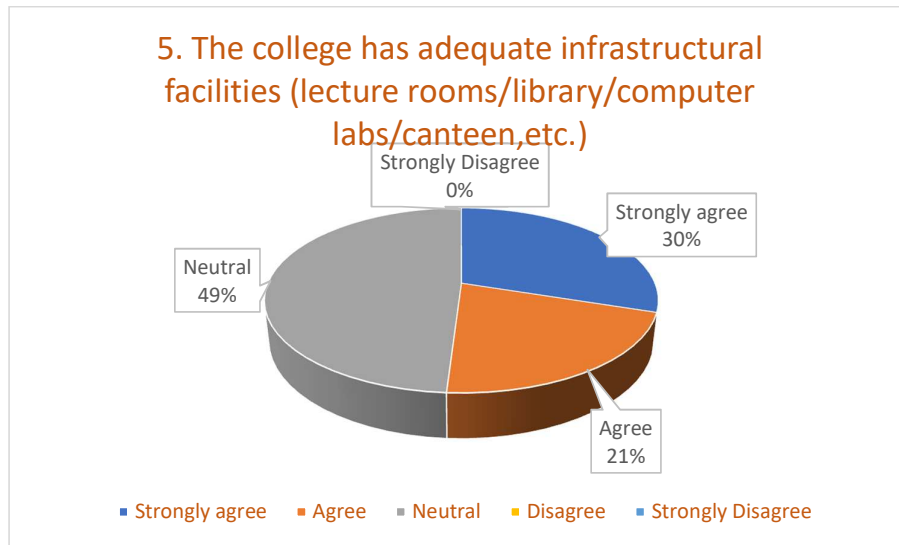
4. Cultural Activities:

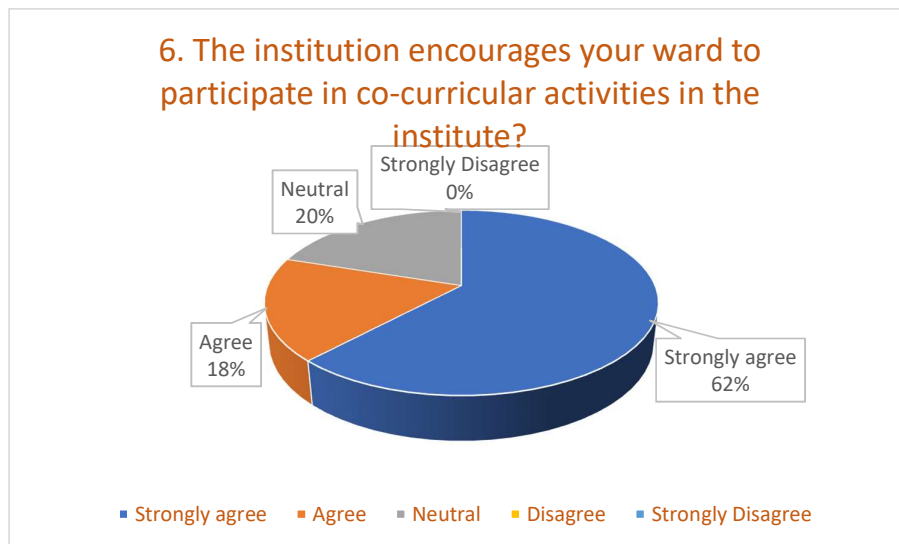
5. Adequate Infrastructural Facilities:

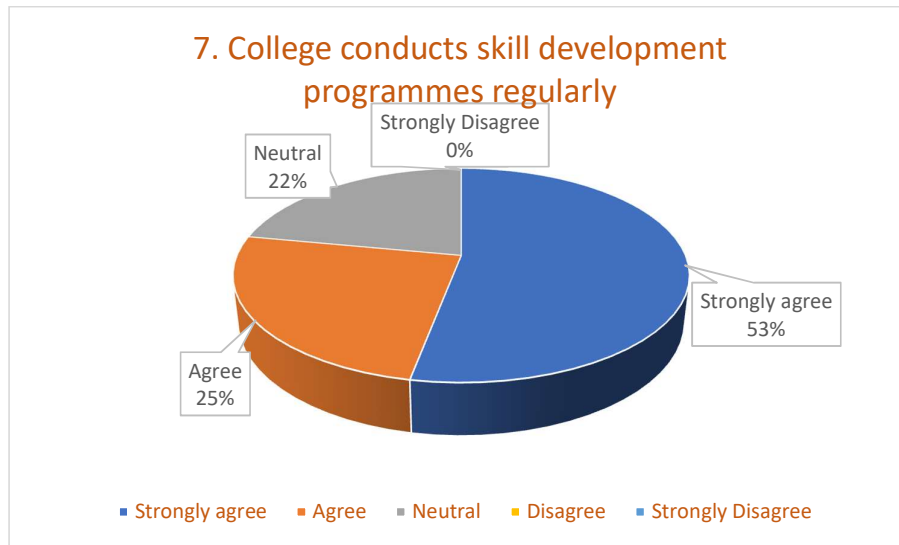
6. Encouragement in Co-curricular Activities:

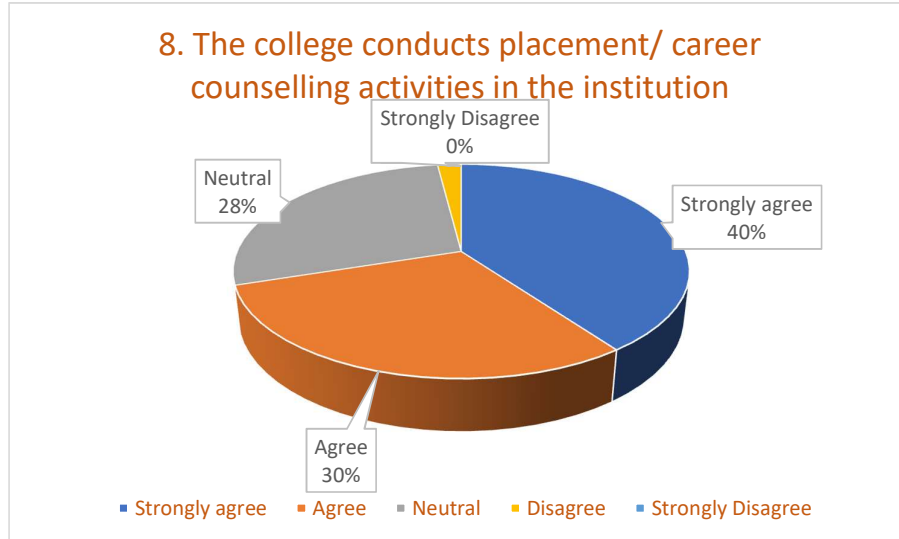
7. Skill Development Programs:

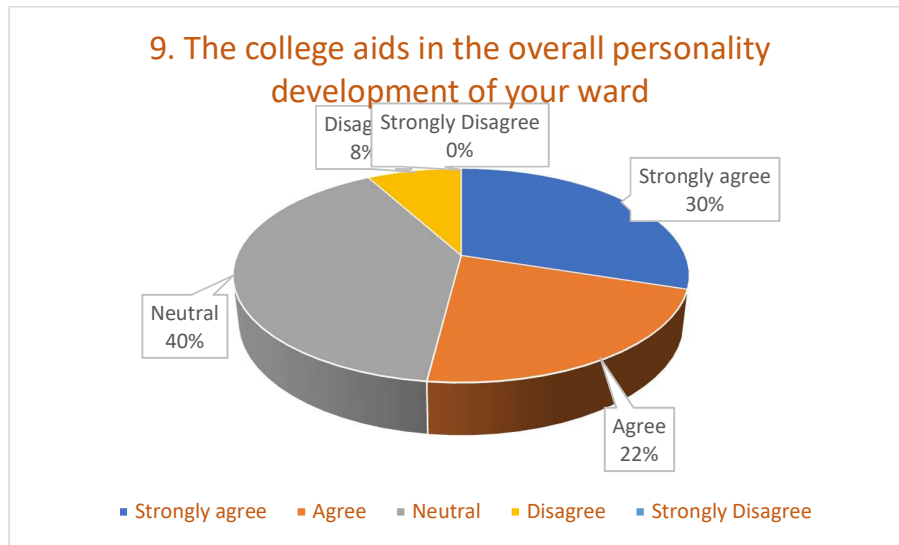
8. Placement/Career Counselling Activities:

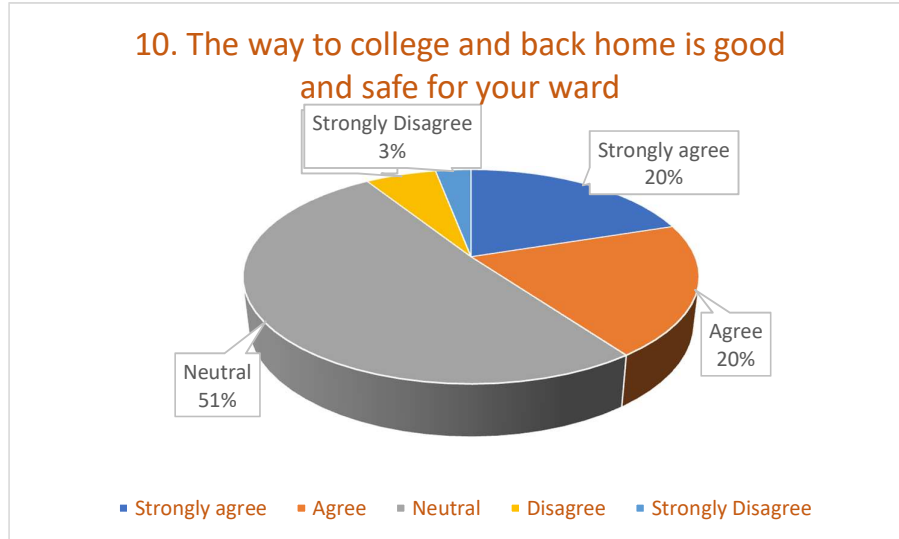
9. Overall Personality Development:

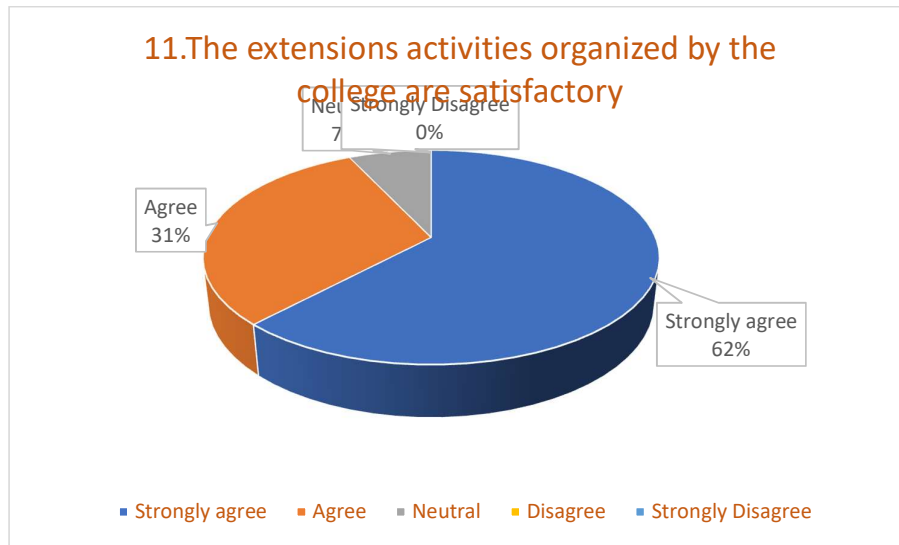
10. Safety and Accessibility:

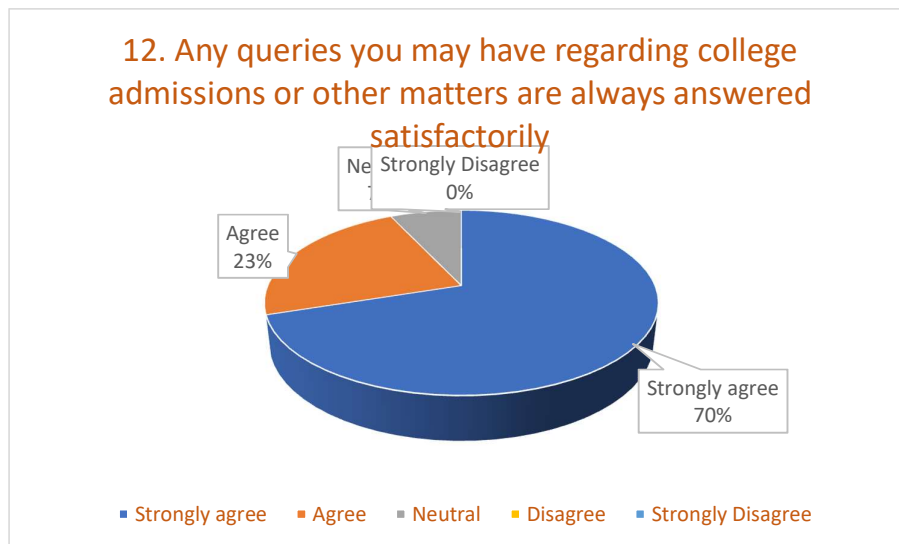
11. Satisfaction with Extension Activities:

- Extension activities are well-received (62 strongly agree, 31 agree), with minimal neutrality (7), indicating satisfaction with these programs' extent and quality.



12. Responsiveness to Queries:

- A high level of satisfaction is noted regarding the institution's responsiveness to queries (70 strongly agree, 23 agree), reflecting positively on the college's communication and support to parents.



Thus, the feedback shows that although parents are generally satisfied with the college's efforts in most areas, there are some notable areas where targeted improvements could further improve the experience of both parents and students at the institution. These areas include inadequate infrastructure, transportation accessibility, and overall personality development.

Recommendations as suggested by the IQAC of the college:

- **Enhance Academic Progression Focus:** Increasing clarity and emphasis on preparation for further studies could address the neutrality observed in this area.
- **Infrastructure Improvement:** Addressing the neutral stance on infrastructural facilities could involve upgrades or expansions to meet growing student needs.
- **Bolster Placement and Career Services:** Enhancing the visibility and impact of career counseling and placement services could improve satisfaction in this critical area.
- **Focus on Personal Development:** Expanding initiatives aimed at personality development could address the mixed responses, ensuring a more comprehensive approach to student growth.
- **Address Safety and Transportation Concerns:** Investigating and addressing concerns regarding commute safety and accessibility could improve student and parent satisfaction in this area.
