## **PROGRAMME OUTCOMES**

## **BA GENERAL**

The BA General programme imparts theoretical and practical knowledge in the languages and literatures and humanities. The subjects taught in this institution within the BA General programme are Bengali, English, Sanskrit, Sociology and Education. In the Choice-Based Credit System, students obtaining a General degree are expected to gain the same extent of competence in the subject they choose as Discipline 1 (DSC1), as they would in the Honours programme of that discipline. Students earning a BA General degree are expected to:

- gain sound training in their respective disciplines and be acquainted with current standards in their fields
- gain the ability for critical thinking, and develop their analytical and problem-solving skills and directing these ability and skills towards comprehending and addressing urgent contemporary societal issues
- gain the foundation necessary to pursue postgraduate studies in the discipline they choose as their first option (DSC1)
- gain the foundation required to undertake academic research in the future
- gain the knowledge and skills required to enter careers in schoolteaching, the civil services, and various other governmental and non-governmental services, and above all, develop into responsible, conscious citizens.
