#### MAJOR COURSES (MJ)

#### Semester I

#### **MJ1 Critical Survey of Sanskrit Literature**

4 credits

CO1: This course introduces students to Sanskrit literature, from Vedic literature to the Purāṇas. It provides an overview of various Shastra traditions, helping students understand Sanskrit literary and Shastra genres.

#### Semester II

#### **MJ2** Sanskrit Composition and Communication

4 credits

- CO1: This course focuses on the construction of Sanskrit declension, conjunctions, and suffixes.
- CO2: Students will gain proficiency in composing grammatically correct sentences, enhance their communication skills in Sanskrit, and become familiar with different genres of Sanskrit composition.

#### SKILL ENHANCEMENT COURSES (SEC)

## SEC1 Reading and Writing Skills in Devanāgarī and Brāhmī scripts.

3 credits

**CO1:** This course familiarizes students with the Devanāgarī and Brāhmī scripts, focusing on their discovery, evolution, and historical development.

**CO2:** Students will become proficient in reading and writing both scripts.

## **SEC2 Computer Applications for Sanskrit**

3 credits

CO1: This course prepares students with knowledge of interactive learning tools for teaching Sanskrit, including word processing, recording tools, and Sanskrit Unicode typing techniques.

#### MINOR COURSES (MI; to be taken by students of other disciplines)

#### Semester I

## MI1 History of Sanskrit Literature

4 credits

CO1: This course introduces students to Sanskrit literature from the Vedic period to the Purāṇas, providing an overview of various Shastra traditions. It explores classical Sanskrit poetry, Ayurvedic theory, and gives a basic understanding of Jyotiṣa Shastra.

#### **Semester II**

#### **MI2 General Grammar and Composition**

4 credits

**CO1:** This course helps students understand the construction of Sanskrit declensions, conjunctions, and suffixes.

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CO2: Students will develop skills in Sanskrit composition, understanding various grammatical structures and genres.
